To be eligible for the scholarship, students must be in grade 12; planning on studying at a SK post-secondary school in the fall after school; have completed the last two years of high school in SK; have a farming background; have a parent or guardian who own/rent and pay taxes to a rural municipality and live in a rural area. Part of the application process is to write a thousand

word essay on the importance of safety and health on their farm or safety and health hazards on their farm.

Deadline: Early February

**Terry Fox Humanitarian Award Program** – 20 X \$7000 annually for up to 4 years.

For students attending any Canadian university or college and pursuing any program. Award recipients must meet the following criteria: involvement in voluntary humanitarian work; Canadian citizens or landed immigrants; undergraduates studying towards their first university degree or diploma at a Canadian post-secondary institution in Canada; maintain a satisfactory academic standing and continued involvement in voluntary humanitarian and community work.

Deadline: February 1
