Wendy's Classic Achiever Scholarship Awards – 30 x awards up to \$5000

Open to well-rounded graduating students with at least a 70% average, extra-curricular and community involvement, and will pursue post-secondary education. Students need to apply on-line at www.wendysclassicachiever.ca. Review the checklist that is provided to make sure you have all the necessary information prior to starting. There is also an early bird deadline sometime in early October.

Deadline: Early November

Burger King Scholars – One nomination per school, \$1000

Nomination and awarded based on the fact that the student is in their grade 12 year, have at least a 70%, work an average of 15 hours a week, participate in community service or similar co-curricular activities, demonstrate financial need, plan to enroll in post-secondary education, must be a resident of the US or Canada. Letters of reference will also be required.

Deadline: Sometime in December

Father Ted Colleton Scholarship – 1st Prize \$1500; 2nd Prize \$800 and 3rd Prize \$500

The Interim newspaper and Niagara Region RTL are proud to co-sponsor this program. This scholarship honors the lifetime pro-life work of Father Ted both in Canada and in Kenya over 60 plus years of priestly ministry. The scholarship program for the 2009-2010 year includes writing an essay of 800 – 1000 words in length on the following theme: The culture of death is all-pervasive, arising in one little corner and then engulfing the whole culture.
