Scholarship Information

SIAS – Scholarship Site

Each SIAS campus has their own scholarship, awards and bursaries handbook that students can use to identify possible scholarships. This handbook is used for new students and second/third year students.

Some key scholarships that you want to be aware of as a new student are:

[Centennial Merit Scholarship](#) (for year 1 students only)

- At least one scholarship is awarded for each applied certificate (\$1500), certificate and diploma (\$2500) program of 20 weeks or more per campus.

PotashCorp Bursary – 50 bursaries of \$1000 (Please see appropriate Campus Fall General Application.)

Crown Investment Corporation Bursary – 20 bursaries of \$5000 (Please see appropriate Campus Fall General Application.)

SaskEnergy Awards- 25 awards of \$1000 (Please see appropriate Campus Fall General Application.)

SaskPower Industry Awards – 8 bursaries of \$3000 (Please see appropriate Campus Fall General Application.)

Awards for Apprentices (if you are completing an apprenticeship program)

University of Regina

1. Centennial Merit Program

Centennial Merit Plus Scholarship (\$3000)

- No separate application required

- Eligibility is assessed based on the admission process.
- Students entering the U of R, Campion, Luther, FNUC and who have an average of 95% or higher and will be registered in a minimum of 12 credit hours throughout the semester is paid out.

Centennial Merit Scholarship (\$2000)

- Same requirements as above except you need a 92% - 94.9% average.

As additional funds become available the U of R will then award entrance scholarships to students with averages below 92% in descending order until funds are exhausted.

2. **U of R Faculty of Business Administration Excellence program Entrance Scholarship**

- Value of \$500 for students entering into their first year into business administration and have an 85% or higher.

3. **Hill-Ivey HBA Option - \$40 000 Scholarship**

- Deadline March 15
- Open to students with a 95% or higher and have demonstrated leadership.

4. **Additional Competitive Entrance Scholarships**

- Deadline March 15

University of Saskatchewan

1. **Greystone Scholars Society**

- Students who are nominated and meet the 95% or higher requirements will be guaranteed an award of at least \$3000 along with a number of other benefits. To find out how to calculate the average, please check out his [link](#).

2. **Guaranteed Scholarships**

- Apply for admission and submit your marks by February 15 to be eligible for three average calculations which could earn you money.
- Three averages: after grade 11, after semester one of grade 12 and at the end of grade 12.
- Guaranteed cash:

- 95% or greater	\$3000
- 93%-94.9%	\$2000
- 90% - 92.9%	\$1000
- 85% - 89.9%	\$500

3. [Competitive Entrance Awards](#)

- On-line application form, and form many of the scholarships you will need to submit additional documentation.
- Remember to self-report your marks when applying for admission. However, if you want to be considered for any entrance awards YOU WILL NEED TO SEND IN A TRANSCRIPT, with your semester one marks and the classes you are taking in second semester.
- Deadline is February 15
