Fine Foods/Express Foods Community Youth Challenge Scholarship

Eligibility criteria is as follows: parent/guardian(s) must be a resident of Saskatchewan or Manitoba, must be enrolled in high school; student must be in regular attendance; must complete grade 12 requirements; must be a resident of a participating store or a student that is bussed into a community with a school that had a participating store will be eligible for a scholarship; and the student must be a participant in community or school activities. Submissions must be accompanied with a resume that describes any activities involving extracurricular activities, sports and public/community service and future goals. A letter must accompany resume from the organizations they are involved with. Open to a spouse or dependent of an HSAS member enrolled in full-time studies at a post secondary educational institution leading to a degree, diploma or certificate. A lottery system is used to select successful applicants – up to 20 scholarships are awarded.

Deadline: Must be received no later than September 15

Johnson Inc. Scholarship – 100 x \$1000

Open to all Canadian residents completing high school and who are beginning post-secondary education are eligible to apply for a Johnson Scholarship. SaskTel Scholarships – 8 x \$3000

Offered to students attending post-secondary institutions in SK who are studying in a field directly related to telecommunications. To be eligible you must be a SK resident, enrolled or plan to enroll in full-time studies (for a minimum of eight months) at a post-secondary educational institution in SK, be enrolled in a degree, diploma, or certificate program directly related to telecommunications (computer science, engineering, accounting, and business administration), and have achieved a minimum 75% average in their most recent educational standing.

Deadline: September 30

SGI Corporate Scholarship – 8 x \$2500 (four to university students and four to students attending a technical institute – 2 are reserved to diversity candidates)

To be eligible applicants must be a SK resident, enrolled full-time in a certificate, diploma or degree program related to the business needs of SGI at a post-secondary campus in SK, have a minimum of 70% and demonstrate contribution to community, extracurricular activities or commitments made in balancing work, education and home responsibilities. Cal Callahan Memorial Bursary – varies x \$6000

Awards are based on the character, service and leadership potential. Student must be entering university in the fall after they graduate with a minimum average of 85%, a Canadian citizen. You may seek “sponsorship” through the school (earlier deadline) or you may apply directly. TD Canada Trust Scholarship for Outstanding Community Leadership – 20 x \$70 000
