Are you:

A Grade 12 student or recent graduate (the past two years) in Saskatchewan?
Planning to take agriculture-related post-secondary education beginning in the fall of 2012?

Do you:

Look forward to a career in agriculture?
If you said YES to all of the above, apply for the Saskatchewan Agriculture Student Scholarship.
Details are below.

What do I need to do?

- i) Write an essay of approximately 750 words; or produce a three-minute video essay; and
- ii) Provide a letter of recommendation from a teacher, agricultural industry or community leader.

Essays need to address one of two topics:

- i) The future information and technological needs of agricultural producers; or
- ii) One or more common myths about agriculture. Essays must dispel the myth(s) through research, facts and statistics.

- All essays, completed application form and a letter of recommendation must be received by **Feb. 15, 2012**, to be considered for the scholarship.
- All entrants must complete an application form available at Ministry of Agriculture Regional Offices; Ministry of Agriculture head office in Regina (100-3085 Albert Street); from your high-school career counsellor; or online at www.agriculture.gov.sk.ca/Scholarship.
- E-mail entries to agriculture.scholarship@gov.sk.ca.
- All entrants must provide a letter of recommendation from a teacher, agricultural industry or community leader. Recommendations from an immediate family member will not be accepted.
- A total of 10 scholarships will be awarded worth \$1,000 each.
- Grade 12 students or recent graduates in Saskatchewan who are entering full-time agriculture-related post-secondary studies in 2012 are eligible. Proof of acceptance to a post-secondary institution must be received by March 15, 2012.
- Recent graduates must have graduated high school in Saskatchewan within the past two years and have not yet attended any post-secondary institute.
- Essays will be judged on the quality of the submission, logical and coherent flow of ideas that are relevant to the topics outlined above, and compliance with eligibility and entrance requirements.
- Winners will be announced in the Spring of 2012. The Ministry of Agriculture reserves the right to publish or promote winning submissions as deemed appropriate by the Ministry.
- Saskatchewan Ministry of Agriculture employees and their immediate family members are not eligible to participate in the program.
